## HURRICANE CONDITIONS (HURCONs)

### HURCON 5 (96 hrs prior)

- Check insurance policies
- Document personal inventory
- Develop family/personal plan (include pets)
- Check/build evacuation kit
- Brief family members on actions to take in an emergency
- Update Air Force Personnel Accountability and Assessment System (AFPAAS)
- Identify closest shelter

### HURCON 4 (72 hrs prior)

- Monitor local T.V. and radio
- Activate family/personal plan
- Check evacuation kit
- Check prescriptions and food
- Brief family members
- Fuel vehicles and generators
- Secure loose yard items
- Notify family, friends and supervisor of plans

### HURCON 3 (48 hrs prior)

- Ensure all items in HURCON 4 are complete
- Monitor T.V. and radio
- Gather evacuation items
- Prepare family for potential evacuation
- Prepare home for hurricane

### HURCON 2 (24 hrs prior)

- Ensure all items in HURCON 3 & 4 are complete
- Monitor T.V. and radio
- Brief family members on evacuation/ride out plan
- Secure home and belongings
- Notify emergency POC and evacuate if officially directed

### HURCON 1 (12 hrs prior)

- Evacuate if still safe to do so
- Monitor T.V. and radio
- Brief family members on evacuation/ride out plan
- Secure home and belongings
- Prepare to "ride-out" category 1 or 2 storms

### HURCON 1C (Caution)

- Winds of 40-57 mph sustained are occurring
- All outside activity is prohibited
- Monitor T.V., radio, P.A. systems, Facebook, etc.

### HURCON 1E (Emergency)

- Surface winds in excess of 58 MPH are occurring
- All outside activity is prohibited
- Monitor T.V., radio, P.A. systems, Facebook, etc.

### HURCON 1R (Recovery)

- Surface winds in excess of 58 MPH are no longer occurring and storm has passed
- Non-essential functions remain closed unless directed otherwise by the wing commander
- All but emergency personnel remain in quarters until further notice

## HURRICANE CATEGORIES

Tropical Storm: Winds 39-73 mph

Category 1: Winds 74-95 mph

Category 2: Winds 96-110 mph

Category 3: Winds 111-129 mph

Category 4: Winds 130-156 mph

Category 5: Winds greater than 157 mph

## PREPARING YOUR HOME

- Trim trees and shrubs to prevent damage
- Secure outdoor items as they may become a hazard
- Know how to turn off gas, water, and electric inside your home
- Close, lock and board up windows
- Know what flood zone you live in
